

2024 Syngenta Partner Program Rules & Regulations

(Eastern Canada)

1. Pre-Registration: Growers who registered for the Partner Program (East) in a prior year are automatically registered for the 2024 Partner Program (East). Registration shall remain effective for all subsequent years unless Syngenta receives written notification from the Grower stating that the Grower does not wish to participate in the Partner Program (East).
 - a. Pre-registered growers who DO wish to change any or all of the information contained in their previous registration for the Partner Program (East) must submit a new Partner Program (East) Form ("Registration Form") with the revised information by the Registration Deadline.
 - b. Pre-registered growers who DO NOT wish to change any information contained in their previous registration for the Partner Program (East) do not need to re-submit a new Registration Form.
2. New Registration: If not already pre-registered, Growers may register for participation in the Program by completing and submitting a "Syngenta Partner Program Registration Form" online Registration Form that is available at: Syngenta.ca/PartnerProgram.
3. Registration Deadline: Registration Forms must be received by Syngenta by September 30, 2024 (the "Registration Deadline").
4. Program Dates: The 2024 Partner Program (East) begins on November 1, 2023 and ends on October 31, 2024 ("Program Period").
5. Program Eligibility: The 2024 Partner Program (East) only applies to Growers who are commercially active in the Provinces of: Ontario, Quebec, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island and Newfoundland & Labrador.
6. Reward Calculation: For each unit of an eligible product purchased by the Grower, point(s) will be awarded by Syngenta in accordance with the Partner Program 2024 Calculator published by Syngenta on the following website: Syngenta.ca/PartnerProgram (the "Calculator"). No points will be awarded for purchases of products not listed in the Calculator. Based on the number of points accumulated by the Grower, the Grower may qualify for a Program rebate reward as set out in the Calculator. Syngenta, in its sole discretion, shall be entitled to make changes to the Calculator.
7. Rules and Regulations: The 2024 Partner Program (East) is expressly subject to the SYNGENTA GROWER PROGRAM RULES AND REGULATIONS ("Rules and Regulations") available at: Syngenta.ca/Rules. The Rules and Regulations are incorporated herein by reference and form an integral part of the 2024 Partner Program East. Each Grower participating in the 2024 Partner Program (East) acknowledges having read and understood the Rules and Regulations.
